# Use your personal device for personal information

Public computers should be treated like public restrooms: **take special care when using them** 

#### On public devices:

Refrain from accessing personal information.

If no other option exists, open in Incognito or Private mode



### Get a mobile data plan

While convenient, public Wi-Fi provides an easy route for hackers to steal passwords and money.

Most secure option: your phone's mobile data. Flying abroad? Consider a local SIM card, as data plans are usually cheaper this way


Using a VPN is also a good option.

#### **Using public Wi-Fi?**

- Access financial information using mobile apps
- Access websites by typing their URL \*and don't follow any link!
- Got a browser warning of any kind? Stop right there. Your network is probably compromised











Phones get stolen; yours could be next.

Verify your backup is enabled iCloud for iPhones, Google Photos for Android

Activate a screen lock
This prevents access to your sensitive data

Enable location tracking and remote wipe
"Find My iPhone" (on iPhone) or "Find My Device" (on Android)

Prepare an action plan: what to do if someone gets lost

Enable family location monitoring available on iPhone and Android devices







## To sum it up
